**Third Way/Idaho National Laboratory to Host Summit on the Future of Nuclear Energy**

***Event will bring together government, private sector leaders including Energy Secretary, White House, NRC Chair, Members of Congress, Industry CEOs, Others***

Washington, DC - Third Way and the Idaho National Lab will host the New Millennium Nuclear Energy Summit, a bipartisan forum on the future of nuclear energy in the United States. The event will feature Energy Secretary Steven Chu, White House Advisor Carol Browner, Nuclear Regulatory Commission Chairman Gregory Jaczko, and more than two dozen industry CEOs, labor and NGO representatives, and energy investors. Senators Tom Carper (D-DE) and George Voinovich (R-OH) are honorary co-chairs of the event. Idaho Congressman Mike Simpson and Senator Mike Crapo will also be attending.

Despite the deep divisions in Washington over energy issues, many on both sides agree that nuclear energy must play a role in the nation's energy and economic future. The summit will provide a forum to start developing broader consensus on the future of nuclear energy in the United States and determining the steps needed to revive the nation's nuclear energy industry.
