School kids whose families can't afford school supplies are getting a helping hand from Idaho National Laboratory employees. The Team INL employee volunteer group has been conducting a site-wide drive to collect backpacks, school supplies and monetary donations for two local non-profits. The drive will conclude this week.

Experts who help keep the nation's critical infrastructure safe are meeting in Idaho Falls this week. The 2010 International Symposium on Resilient Control Systems will focus on the safe and secure operation of systems that control electrical grids, water treatment plants and utilities. Nearly 100 participants are expected.

Ten INL summer interns won scholarships from the Center for Advanced Energy Studies last week.
