Students who intern at Idaho National Laboratory can take heart: INL has been listed among the nation's best internships for the second year in a row. The annual Vault Guide to Top Internships chooses high-caliber internships based on a variety of criteria including training, career prep, pay, type of work and "resume radiance."

Community and business leaders from across Idaho are visiting INL this week. About two dozen Chamber of Commerce members and other interested citizens from the Treasure and Magic valleys are touring INL facilities to learn about INL's contributions to science, technology and Idaho's economy.
